



Checklist for NYS CREP Conservation Plan

- Landowner on initial visit provided a copy of “Appendix to Form CRP-1” (Summary of CREP Program Rules)
- CREP Site Condition Evaluation – “Before” condition
- Conservation Plan Map, with FSA field numbers and acreage
- Soils Map, with brief soil descriptions
- CPA-68 (or Customer Service Toolkit) – Record of Cooperator’s Decisions, including detailed description of land use and treatment
- Appropriate Conservation Practice Job Sheet(s) - available online @ www.nrcs.gov/technical/standards/nhcp.html
- CPA-52 – Environmental Effects for Conservation Plans
- Identification of any Federal, State or Local Permits that may be needed, if construction activities are planned in areas such as streams or wetlands
- AD-1155E (formerly LTP-11A) – Conservation Plan Schedule of Operations
 - All acres enrolled in CREP
 - Cost-share for eligible practices
 - Non cost shared practices, if applicable
 - Time frame and deadline to implement practices and management activities
 - Conservation Practice Operation and Maintenance Requirements agreed to by the landowner – refer to appropriate NRCS Practice Standard and National CRP Practice for specific requirements
 - NY LTP - 1 Establishment Guide for Vegetative Seeding, if applicable
 - NY LTP - 2 Establishment Guide for Trees and Shrubs, if applicable
 - NY LTP - 3 Guide for Permanent Cover Establishment, Operation and Maintenance, if applicable
 - Management activities required for CRP Practices, if applicable
- Review and approval of CREP Conservation Plan (AD-1155E) by SWCD & the COC

Note –

A cultural resources review should be initiated once the plan is approved if any ground disturbing practices are to be implemented.
