REMARKS:

A USDA permit for possession of piranha was secured when Ms. Post purchased the store. It was recommended that Ms. Post inquire as to the need for renewal of the permit. No other species requiring USDA permits were found on the premises.

No puppies were housed anywhere in the store at the time of inspection. Only two personal dogs were housed in the upstairs section of the store. The isolation room upstairs contained no animals.

Mice and rats housed in the puppy room are kept in glass aquariums. There was no evidence of their droppings on the floor in the puppy room.

There was no documentation on information statements regarding treatments for ear mites.

There was no evidence of personnel drawing blood. Ms. Post said no blood is drawn on any animals. Blood draws for Feline Leukemia tests are done by the veterinarian. A phone call by the inspector to the veterinarian verified testing is done through their office. In the phone call, the veterinarian implied that if a Feline Leukemia test was negative on one litter mate or the mother of kittens it is likely that the related animals would also be negative.
