**REMARKS:**

**Marietta says she is going out of business and moving to NC and does not plan to renew her pet dealer's license.**

**Marietta said 15 dogs were taken by the Oswego county SPCA on 6/22/14. The SPCA took all the records for the dogs and Marietta said this is why many records are missing. I spoke to the OCSPCA and verified this information, the SPCA said the records were difficult to understand and incomplete.**

**Although all dog cages were cleaned the facility/room where the dogs are housed must be cleaned on a regular basis in order to avoid buildup of dirt, debris and vermin infestation. I recommend a thorough clean out while dog numbers are low and it is easier to move cages.**

**Water is available during exercise times. I have visually seen dogs out to play and drinking water. In my professional opinion all 6 dogs viewed during inspection appear to be well hydrated.**

**All paperwork is still very disorganized and hard to find.**
