EAR TAGS

The USDA is considering transitioning to the **exclusive** use of 840 RFID tags to promote and advance livestock traceability. NYS will continue to provide free metal NUES tags through Dec. 31, 2021.

USDA RFID TAG PILOT PROGRAM

The USDA has provided NYS AGM with a large delivery of 840 RFID half-duplex white button tags. All Category II Accredited Veterinarians may receive up to 1000 tags at no charge. The tags should preferably be applied to replacement heifers but are acceptable for use on show and exhibition animals as well as for export to localities requiring 840 tags such as Canada, Mexico, and Michigan. The tags should only be applied to animals born in the USA that are residing in New York State. The tags can be applied to either ear, but you will need a tagger specific to the manufacturer (Allflex).

As with all forms of official identification, you are responsible for maintaining records of tag distribution for 5 years with required information: owner/farm name, date of application/distribution, 7 digit PIN (if known), 911 address, official tag #/tag range applied, species, breed sex, age/DOB.
