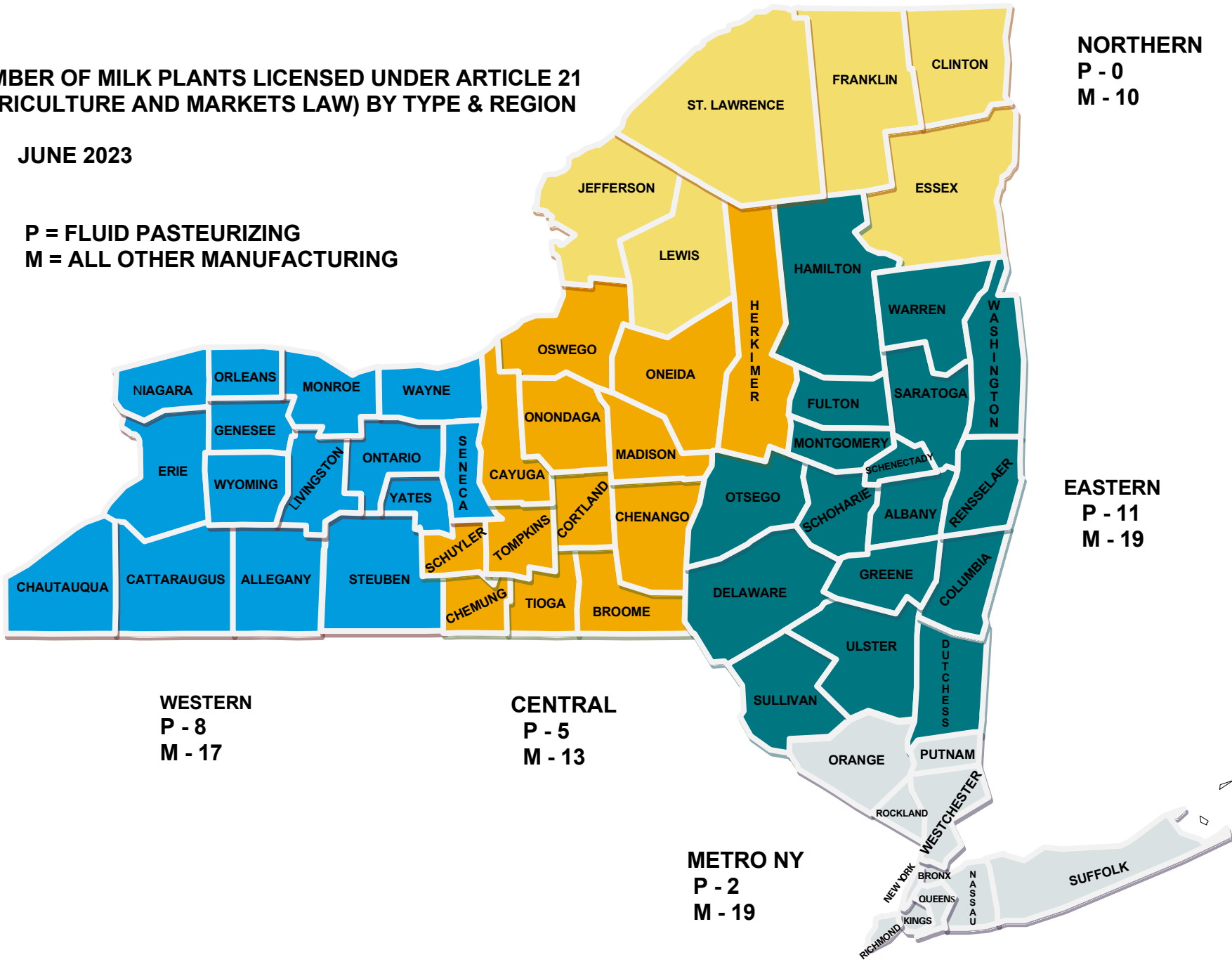

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Foreword

New York State has nearly 3,000 dairy farms that produce 16.1 billion pounds of milk annually, making New York the fifth largest dairy state in the United States. The dairy industry is the state's largest agricultural sector, contributing significantly to the state's economy, generating nearly half of the state's total agricultural receipts, and providing some of the highest economic multipliers in the state.

This 2023 New York State Dairy Statistics Report provides an overview of New York's dairy industry. The report is divided into seven sections, outlining both general dairy statistics and more detail specific areas, including receipts of milk and dairy products, payments to dairy farmers, fluid milk sales, and manufactured dairy products.

Several statistics related to the New York State dairy industry are notable in this report: New York State processors outdid themselves again, making more cheese than ever at over one billion pounds; in 2023, the state's processors made more than 308 million pounds of cream cheese, topping last year's New York State record and ranking New York number one in the United States; and the state's processors were also the national leaders in the production of creamed and low-fat cottage cheeses (221 million pounds), yogurt (880 million pounds), and ricotta (109 million pounds) ([Table 28](#)).

In 2023, the number of dairy cows in the state remained at 630,000, annual production per cow increased by 1.7% to 25,522 pounds, and the total amount of milk produced in the state increased by 2.7%, resulting in a total of 16.1 billion pounds produced.

Fluid milk utilization at New York State plants totaled over three billion pounds, a decrease of less than 1% ([Table 9](#)). Total sales of packaged fluid milk from New York State milk plants remained at 2.9 billion pounds ([Table 22](#)).

The data presented in this report was primarily obtained from the monthly reports filed by milk handlers and processors operating with an Article 21 license in New York State. These reports provide an accounting of dairy receipts and utilization of milk and milk products as well as related information, such as payments and prices received by farmers. Market order statistics were obtained from reports published by the various orders (Federal Market Orders 1 and 33 and the New York State Western Milk Marketing Order).

The Department greatly appreciates the cooperation, assistance, and data provided by individuals, milk dealers, cooperative associations, and public agencies in the preparation of this publication.

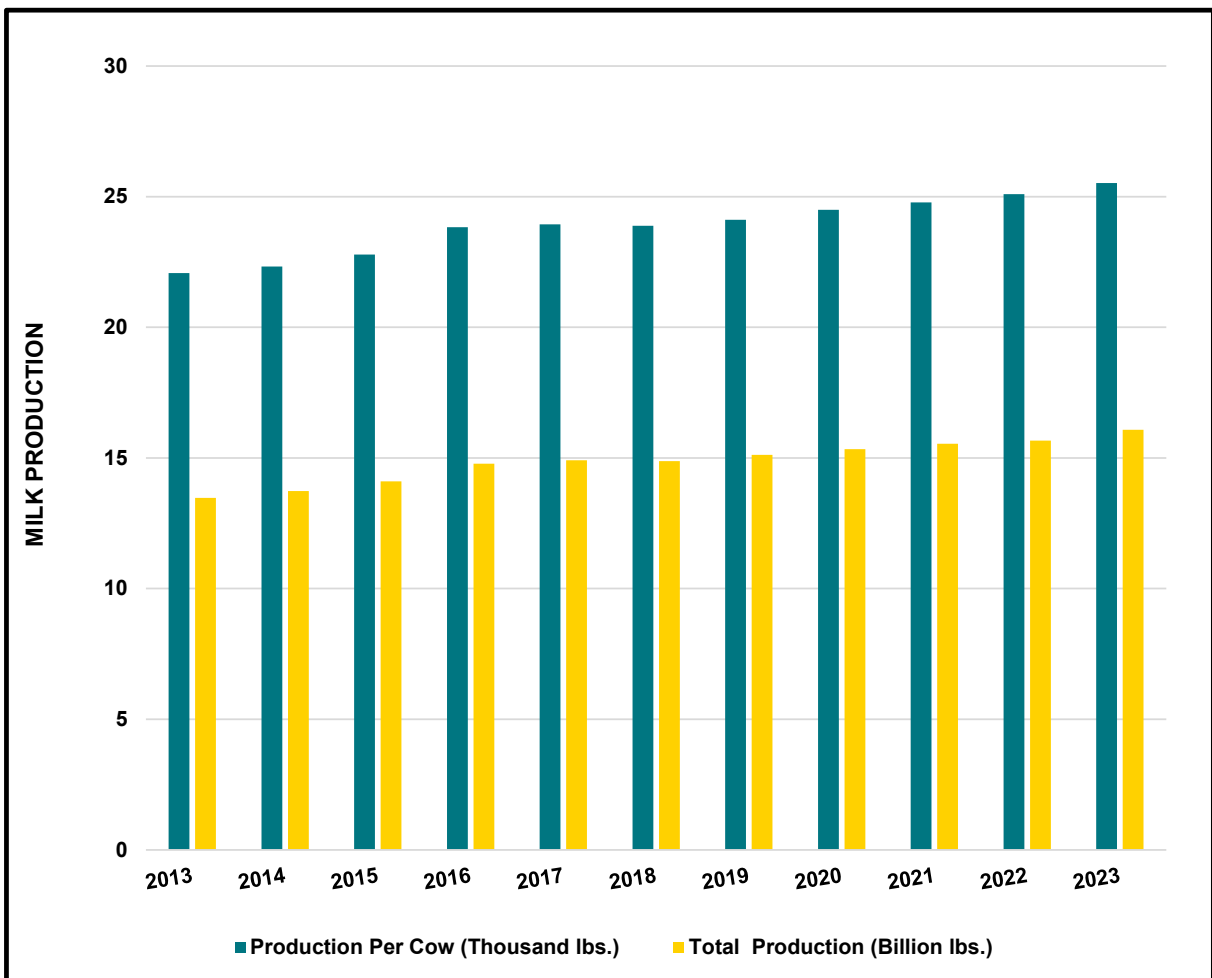

FIGURE 2. NUMBER OF DAIRY PLANTS IN NEW YORK STATE, BY TYPE, JUNE 2016 - 2023

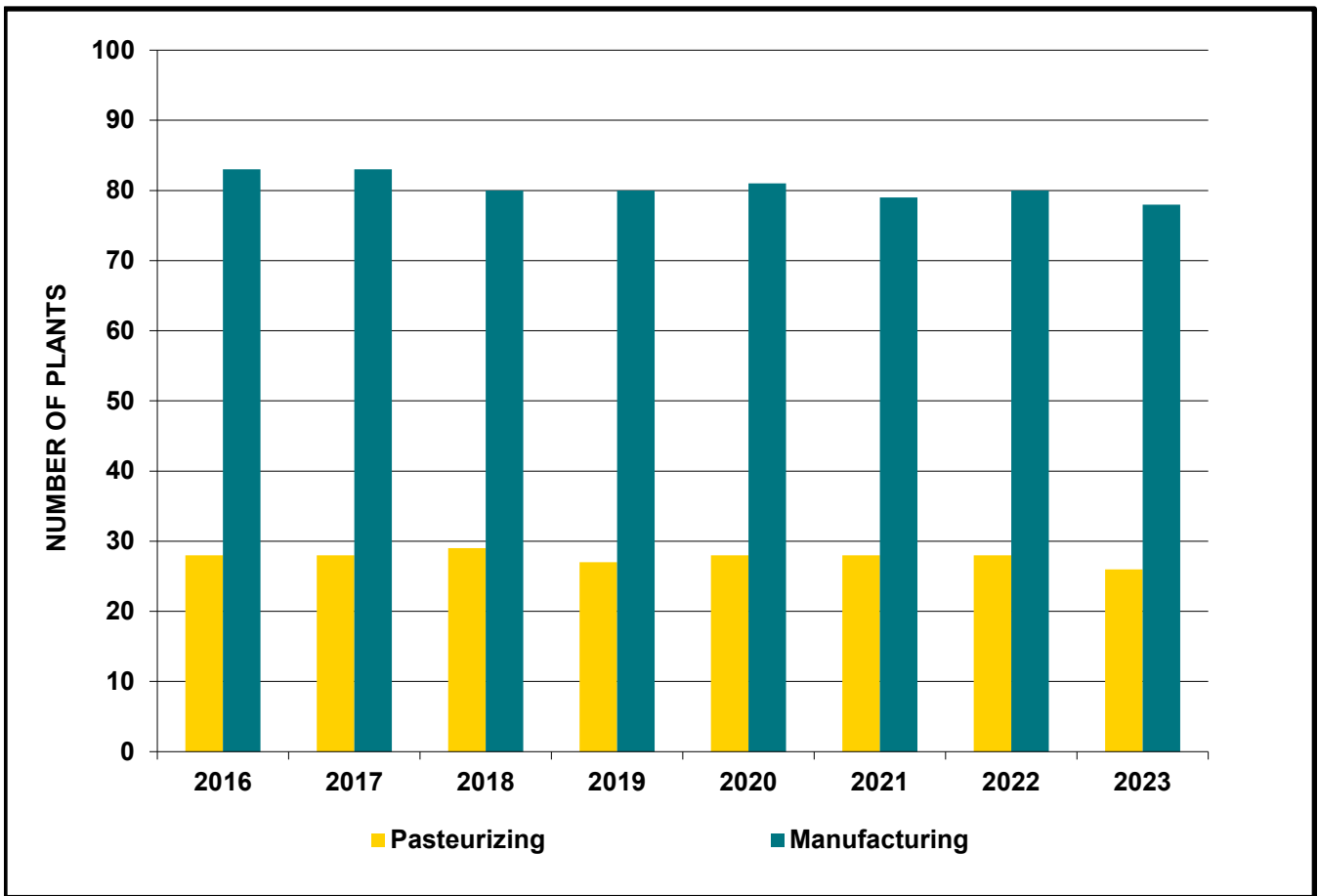

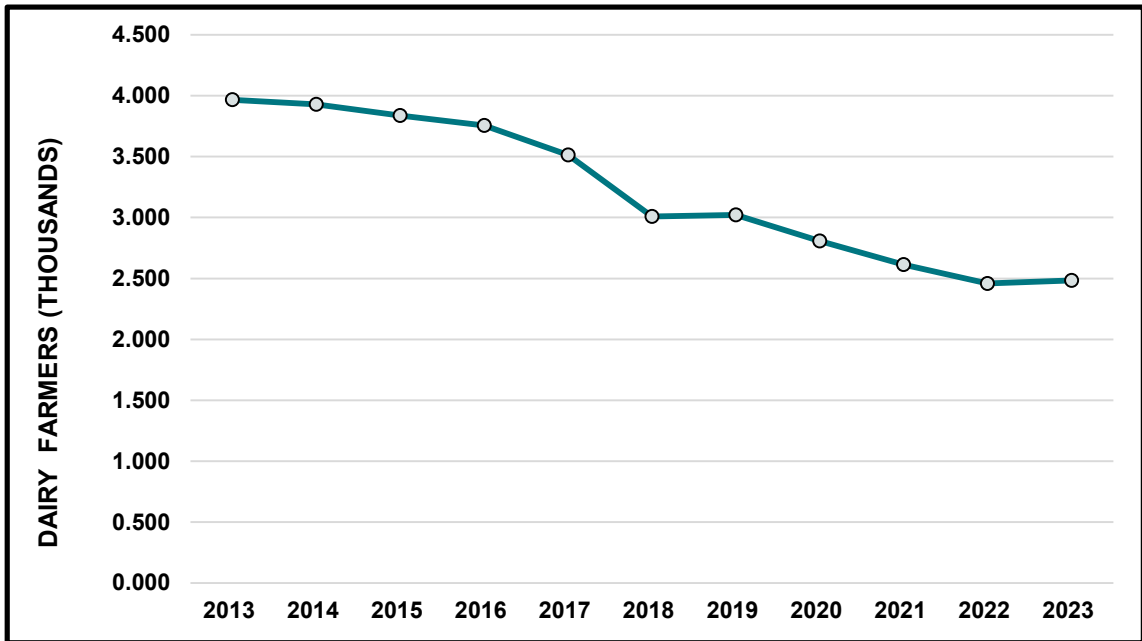

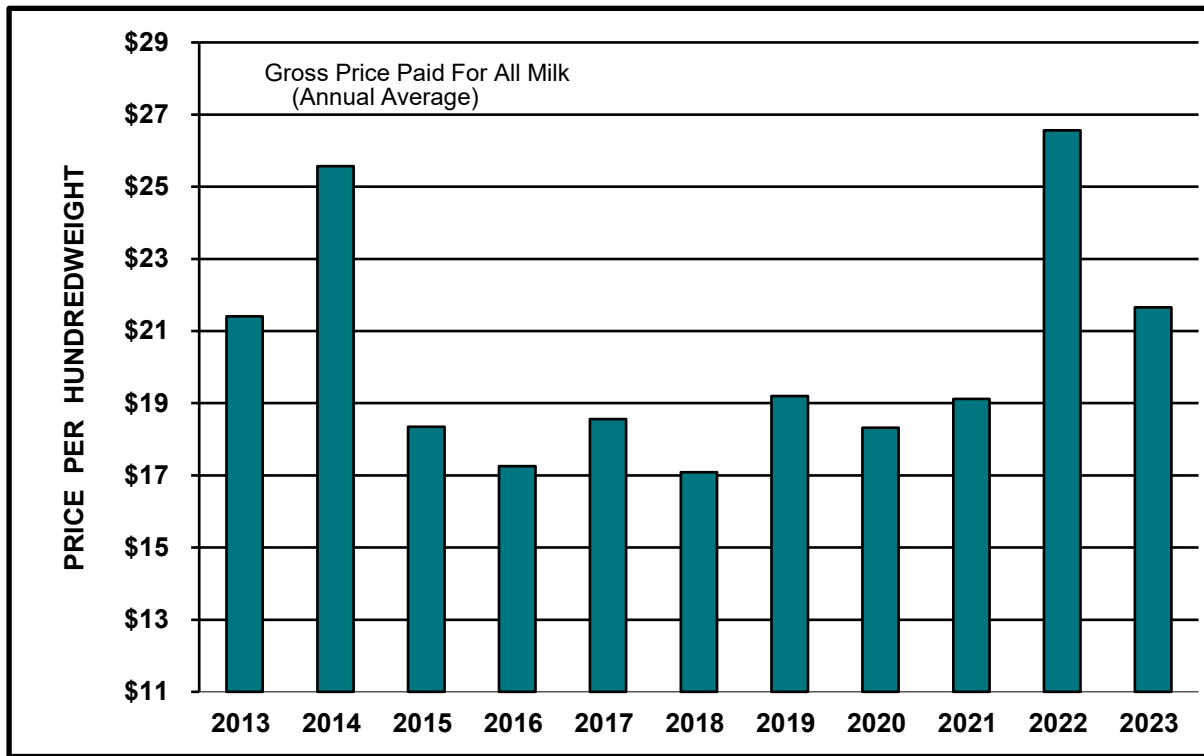

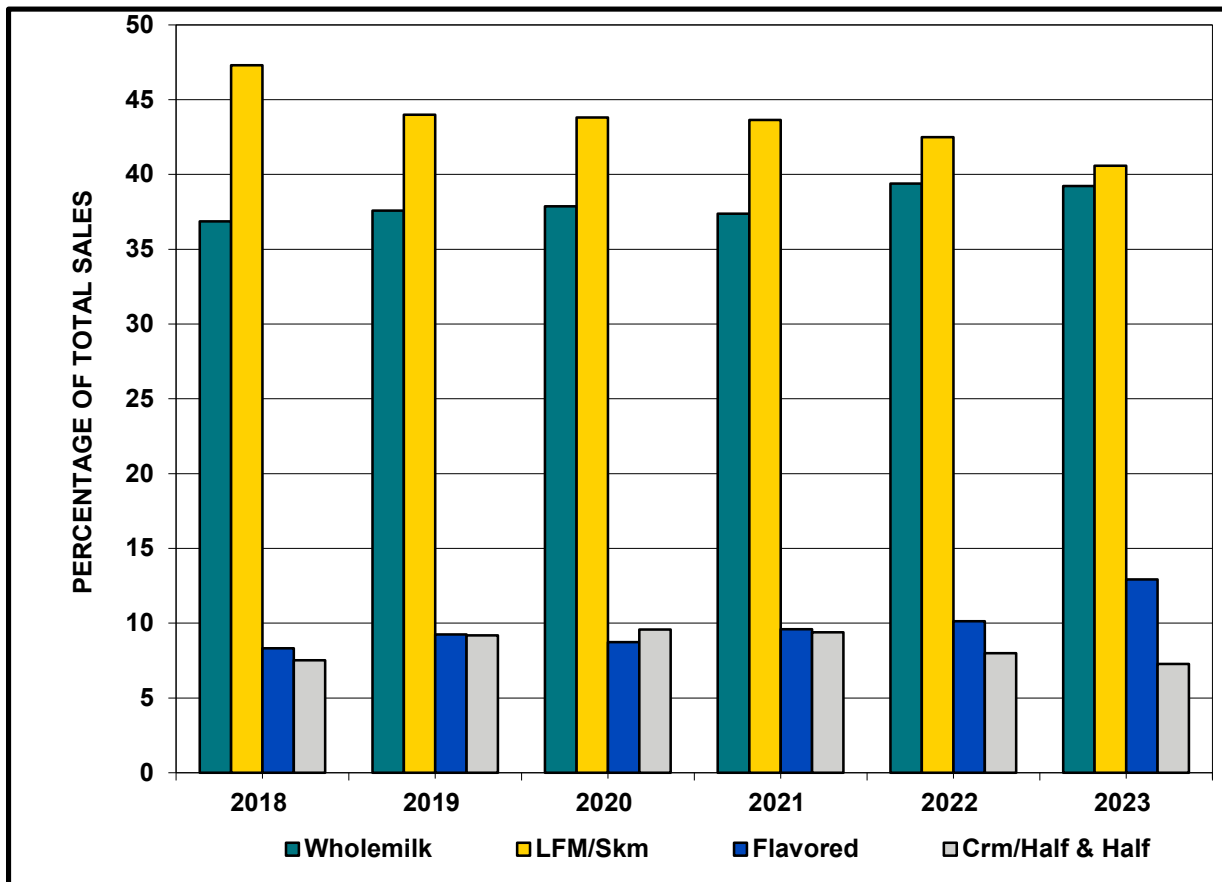

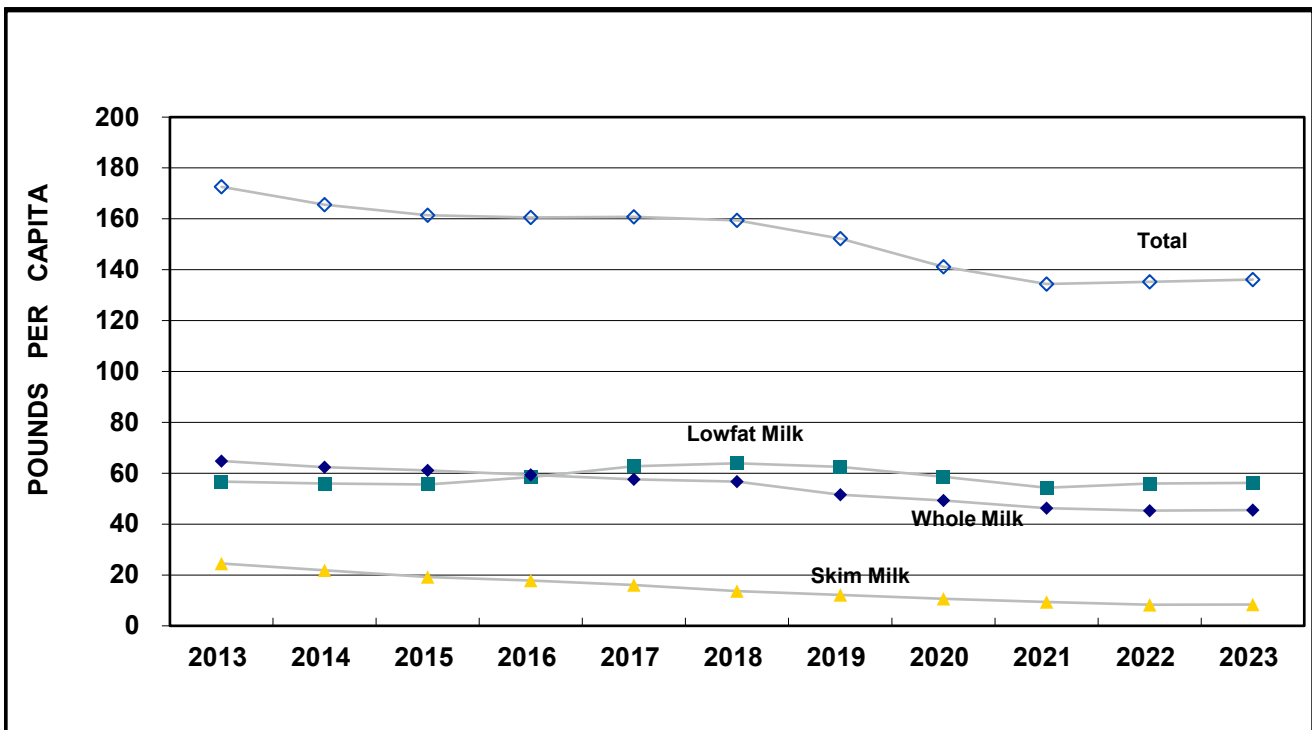

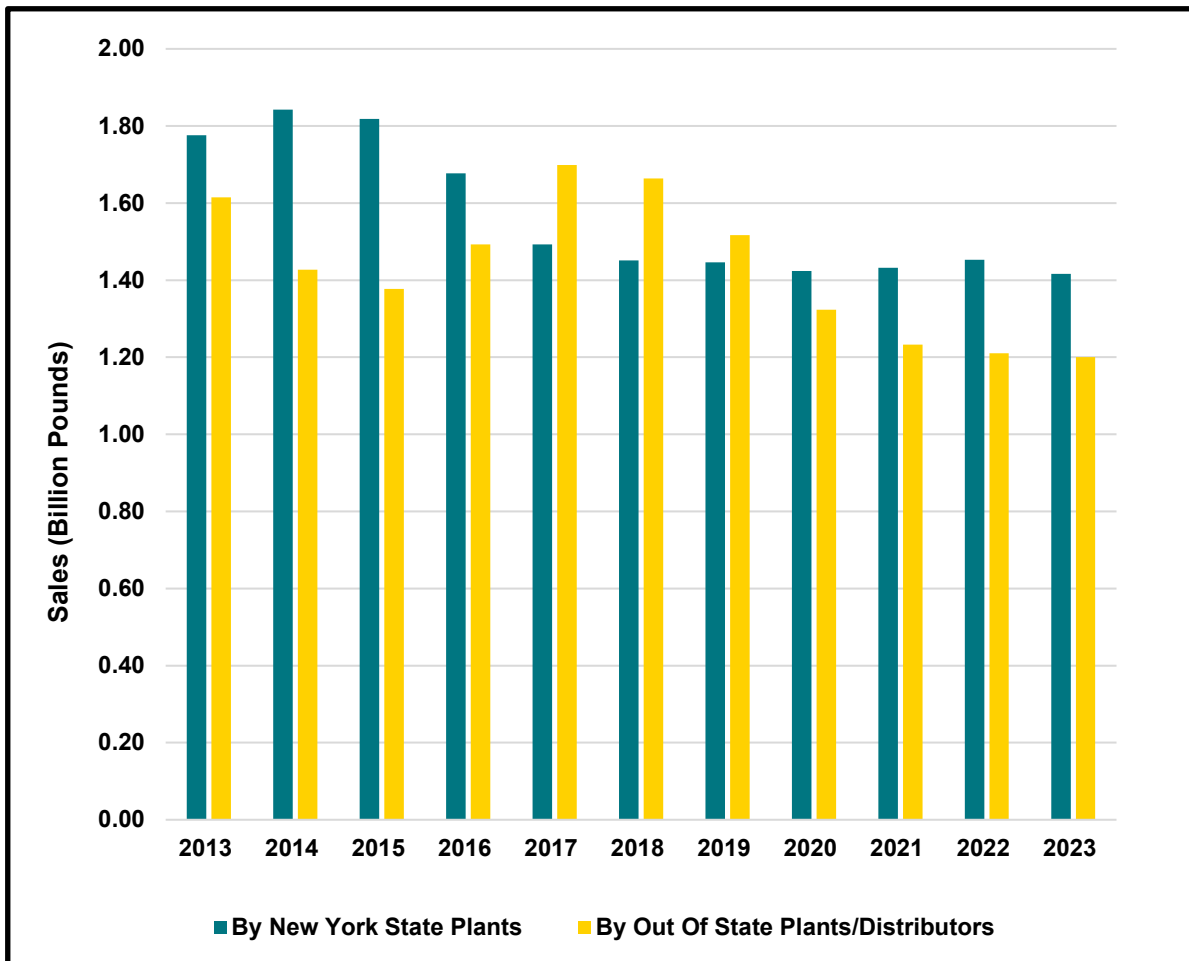

FIGURE 8. CHEESE MANUFACTURED IN NEW YORK STATE DAIRY PLANTS, 2018 - 2023

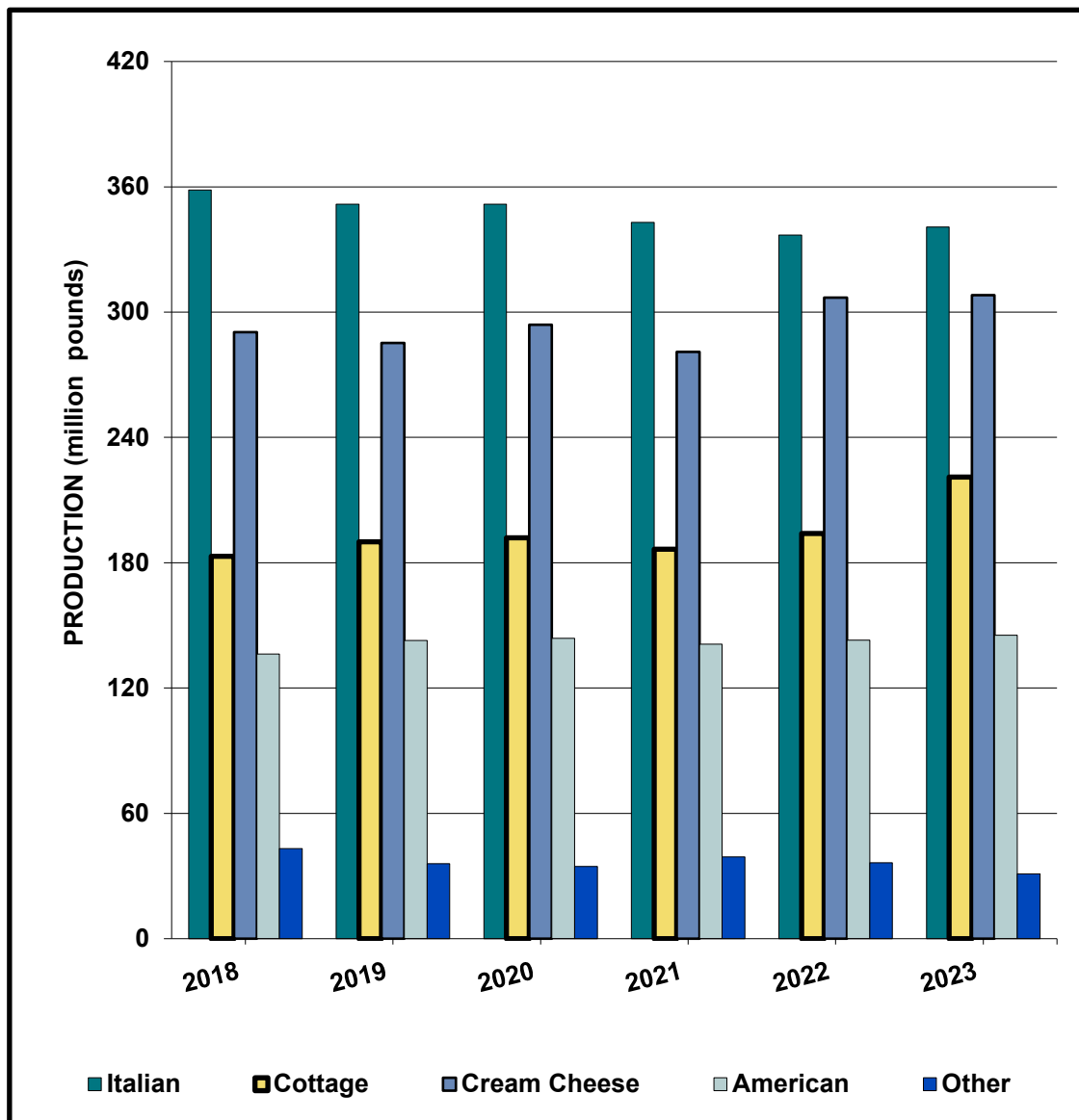

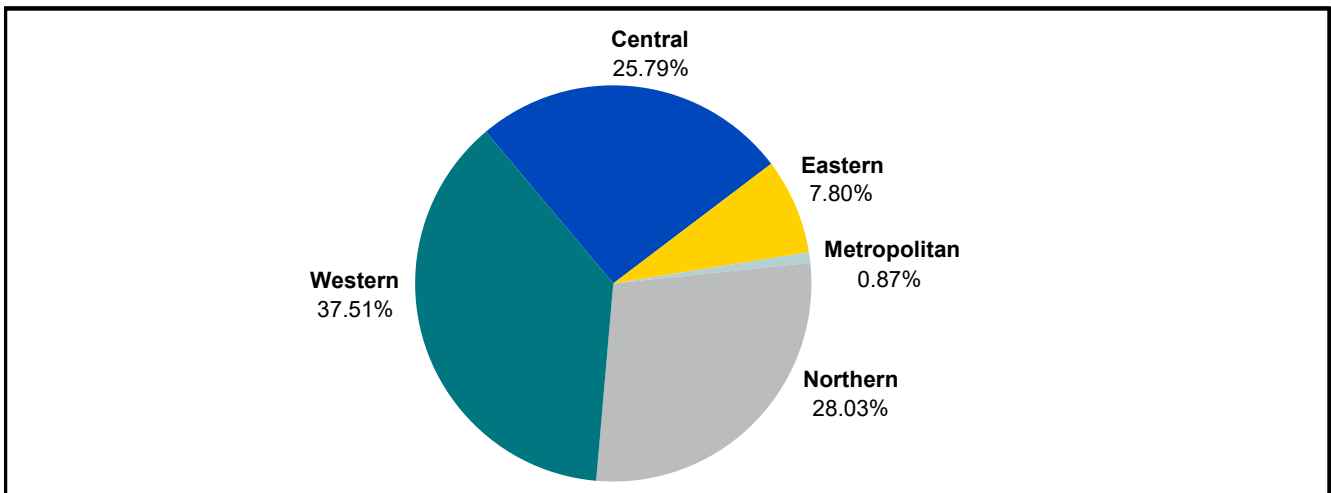

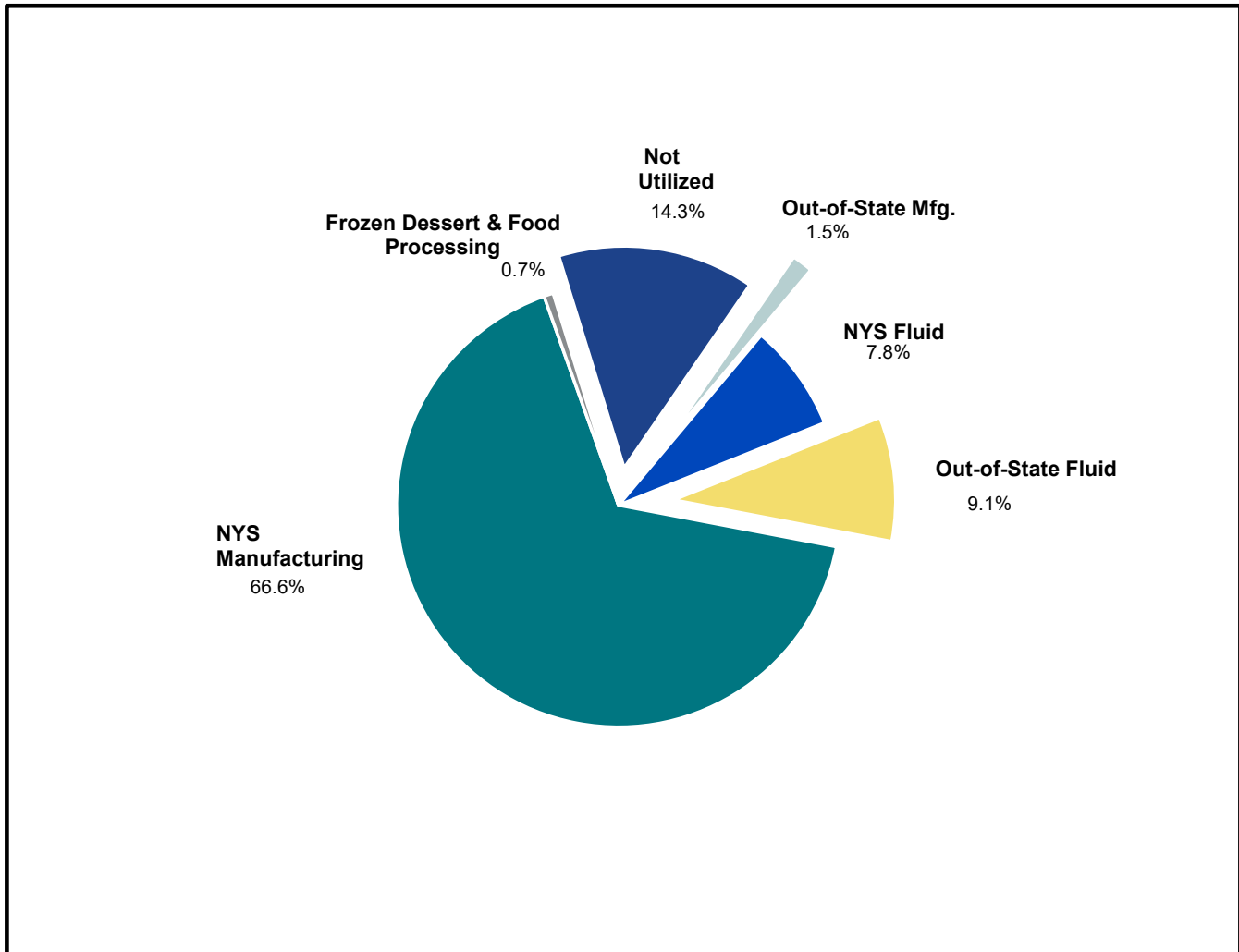

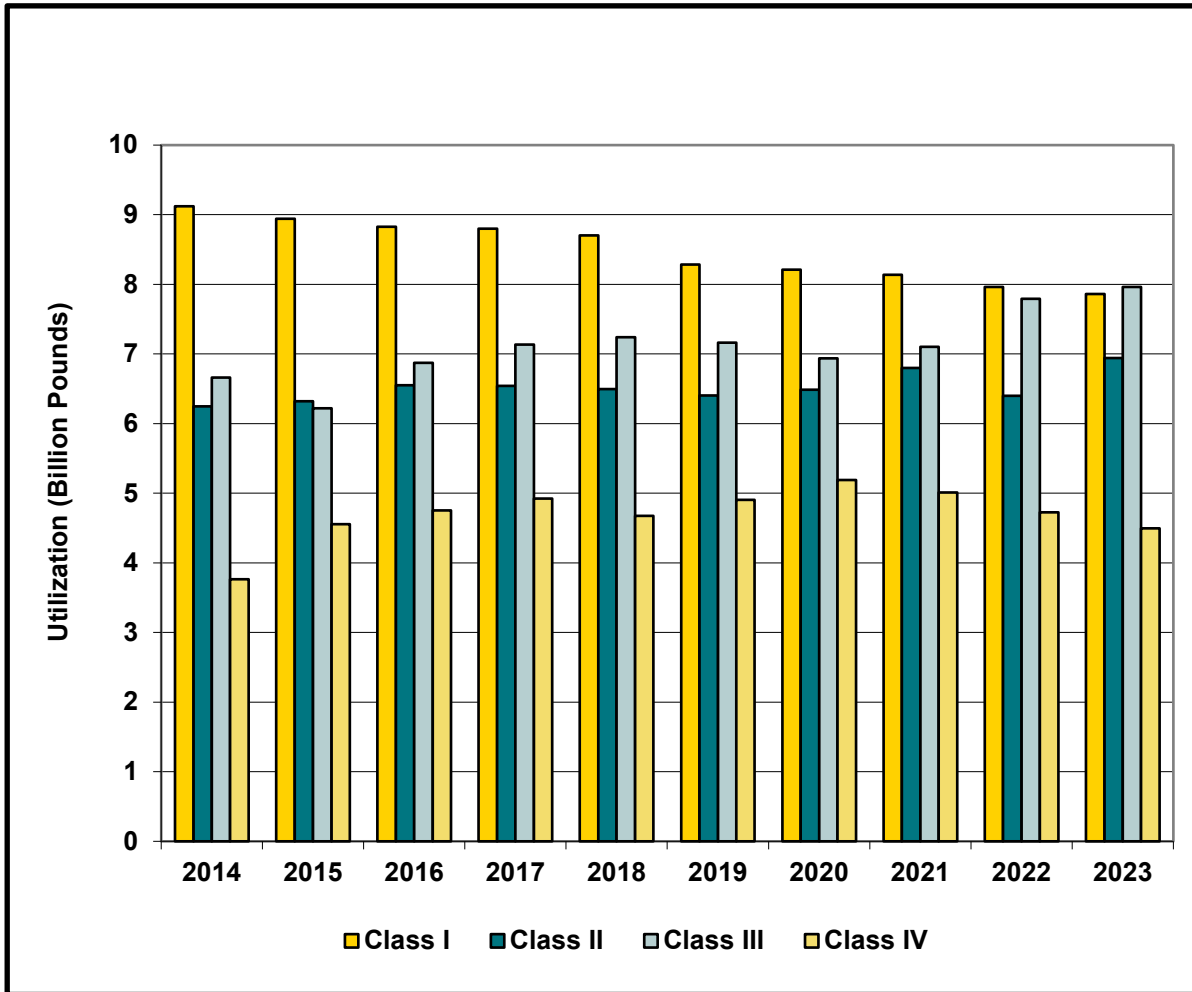

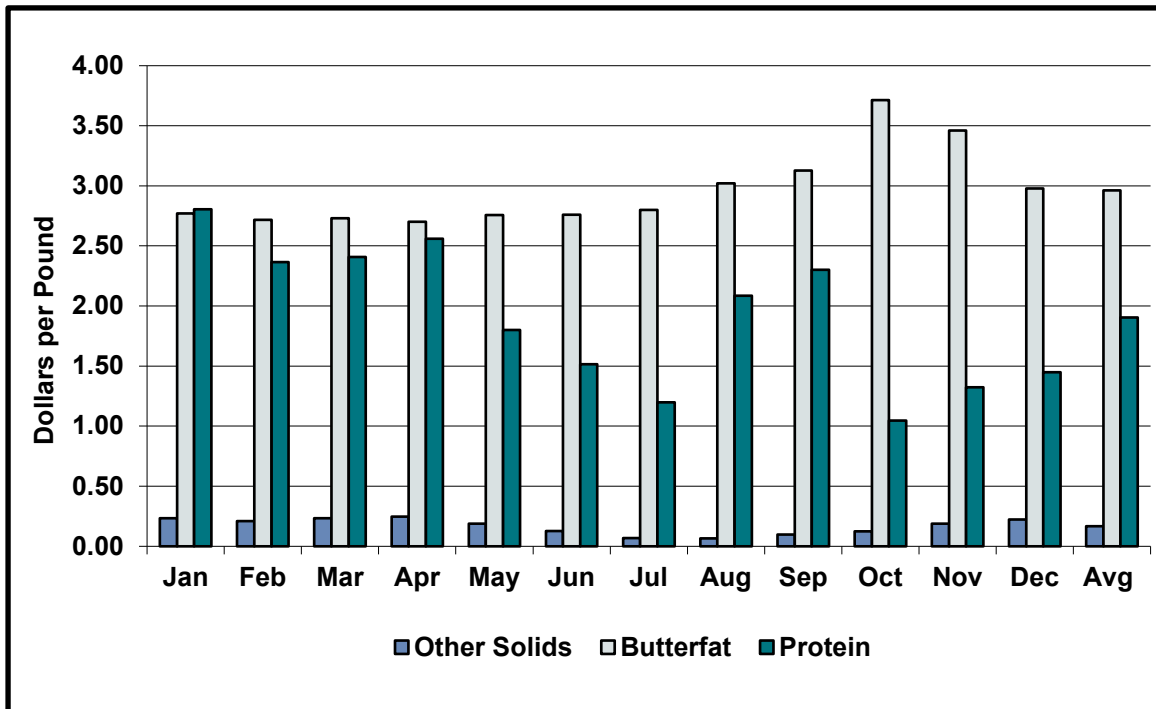
